

ULUNU SAFARIS RULES

Acceptance: All hunters and visitors confirm, when entering the property, that they have received these rules, and that they understand and accept it in total. No amendment will be valid unless confirmed in writing by the owner.

Alcohol: No alcohol may be consumed in the veld and no person under the influence of alcohol is allowed to handle any vehicle or firearm.

Ammunition: No solid ammunition and/or ammunition weighing less than 100 grein may be used for hunting.

Bribery: Please do not attempt to bribe our guides.

Damages: Any damages caused will be paid by the guilty party to the owner.

Discharge of firearms: No shots may be fired if one of our guides is not present and authorised by him. A penalty will be levied for each unauthorised shot fired. If any unauthorised bird or animal is shot, a penalty will be payable.

Group liability: Hunters/visitors make reservations as a group and are treated as such and, accept as a group jointly and separately, liability to comply with the rules as well as for any accounts payable and/or damages caused by them.

Guides: One guide for every 2 hunters with a maximum of 4 guides per group will be made available. Guides are not personal servants and will only help to track and slaughter animals. Identification of animals, hunting and processing of meat is the hunter's own responsibility. Guides collected to accompany you must be returned to their accommodation at the end of the days hunt and/or butchering.

Hunting Area: No hunting or discharging of firearms within a radius of 300 metres of any housing / accommodation.

Interest and costs: Invoices must be paid within 3 days. Interest will be charged on any amount outstanding for 20 or more days. The group leader will be held liable for any collection fees which the owner may incur in the process of collecting outstanding amounts.

Licenses and permits: Our permits do not cover the hunting of birds. Transportation of bush pig / warthog meat requires a special permit. We must be advised prior to the hunt to apply for a special bush pig / warthog permit. The permit does not allow the transporting of the skin, head, or feet.

Ownership: The owner retains ownership of all animals until they are paid in full.

Payment: 50% of accommodation fees will be payable upon reservation.

Proof: Should any dispute arise from any hunting or event that might take place during the hunters/visitors' activities on the farm, the guide's word will be accepted as final and binding on all parties.

Problems: Please clear up any misunderstandings or problems with the farm manager.

Restriction: Only animals specified for hunting on the price list may be hunted. No shot may be fired at any other animal, bird, or plant.

Testing of weapons: Rifles may only be tested at the firing range at Weltevrede, and under supervision of one of our guides. Please limit the number of shots that you fire to 5 shots per weapon.

Vehicles: No vehicles and/or person in possession of a hunting weapon or firearm will be allowed outside the camp if not accompanied by one of our guides. The use of the owner's vehicle must be pre-arranged. A vehicle renting fee will apply. Our vehicles are the responsibility of our guides and will only be driven by them. Hunters may use their own vehicles. No hunting will be allowed from any vehicles.

ULUNU SAFARIS RULES

Wounded animals: Any animals that are wounded will be considered hunted and the full value thereof will be payable. Any blood, bone, skin, meat, or hair that is found, will be adequate proof that the animal is wounded. Please ensure that all wounded animals are tracked down as soon as possible. Although the guides will assist the hunter with tracking of the wounded animals, it remains the sole responsibility of the hunter. Management reserves the right to withdraw any of the guides at any time to assist in the tracking of the wounded animal/s.

Wood: Wood is provided for braaing and not for removal from the farm.
